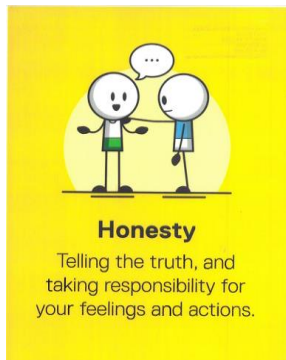

## WHOLE SCHOOL PYJAMA DAY!!!

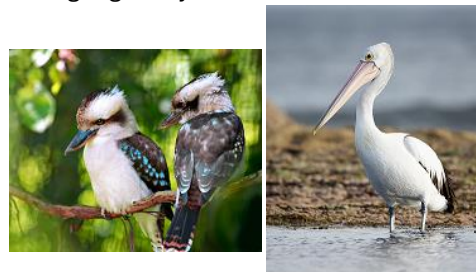
Our junior classes of Nyingarn and Kaarda are organising a Pyjama Day this Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June. Please see attached flyer.
